



STEPS FOR GETTING YOUR CPL

1. Be a legal resident of Michigan and at least 21 years of age and be able to legally possess a firearm.

2. Successfully complete a pistol safety training /CPL course. You will need a certificate of completion and it must state: "This course complies with section 5j of 1927 PA 372."

3. Complete a Michigan Concealed Pistol License application (**DO NOT SIGN IT YET!**) and print it when finished leaving the signature blank.

4. Bring the certificate of completion, the application form, and your state issued ID to your county clerk's office.
5. You will need to pay a (\$100) application fee, and sign the completed application when instructed. You should get a receipt and be instructed on how to provide fingerprints. (There will likely be an additional fee for the fingerprinting)
6. You should get a receipt after being fingerprinted. **Keep this Receipt!** If it takes more than 45 days of the receipt to receive your CPL, it becomes your temporary CPL until you receive your physical card.
